SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION OF THE SCIENCE COLLABORATION CENTRE

Atomic Energy of Canada Limited (AECL), Canada's nuclear Crown corporation, and Canadian Nuclear Laboratories (CNL), Canada's premier nuclear science and technology laboratory, welcomed a number of special guests to the Chalk River Laboratories this month to celebrate the opening of the Science Collaboration Centre, a newly-constructed office complex at the campus.

Scheduled to open its door to 450 CNL employees, the new sixstory, 9,500 m2 facility will serve as the central planning and collaboration space for the company's science and technology program. Constructed using mass timber products sourced from Northern Quebec, the innovative and sustainable new facility features modern office space, 44 meeting rooms, collaborative flex spaces, a university-style auditorium with 200 theatre-style seats, a welcoming library space, and a rooftop terrace.



Speak-Up Culture:

When Leaders Truly Listen, People Step Up

Synopsis:

We know the impacts of poor leadership: lackluster performance, missed opportunities, deleterious cultures, and, in some cases, disaster. They can create a speak-up culture, one in which people feel it is both safe and worth it to share their ideas, concerns, disagreements, and even mistakes - all for the betterment of the organization.

Speak-Up Culture is for leaders at all levels- from senior executives who believe in putting people and purpose first; to mid-level supervisors who wish to lead better and nurture the voice of their people; to aspiring leaders who want to uncover their strengths and better provide support to those in their span of care. All these leaders share a common desire to know a better way to behave as a leader. They want to operate in a team and culture where people are engaged and willingly speak up, for the success of the whole organization.

NOVEMBER IPDA WEBINAR SERIES

Collaboration being center stage in IPD initiatives, we discuss the dimensions to measure collaboration within a facilitated enlarged project team. Throughout a 3 years action research (AR) methodology with our research partner, the Société Québécoise des Infrastructures, we developed the collaborative index that is nowadays used for every single facilitated meeting of projects over 5 million dollars. This partenarial study extended between 2019 and 2022 with a total of six (6) AR learning cycles leading to multiple case studies with significant and rich results regarding collaboration within the project team. As a result, collaboration index measurements (CIMQ) within the conception and planification teams was created. Quebec's government as a representative of complex adaptive social systems is making strides in organizational effort in reaching for better project performance through ensuring rigorous planning, implementation and monitoring of projects (Government of Quebec, 2022). We will discuss the index, its dimensions but also the impact of multidisciplinary and multiorganizational stakeholders' collaboration in project cycle stages to improve and accelerate the project's execution process while maintaining a satisfactory level of collaboration between the parties. This CIMQ born out of this extensive action research contributes directly to innovation of complex system, especially towards sustainable development objectives as collaboration is a key ingredient for successful and performing projects.
