



<u>Invitation to Participate – IPD Owners' Forum in Toronto on October 23, 2019</u>

We are looking for Canadian building owners to participate in a forum organized by UBC researchers that is investigating the adoption of IPD in Canada. Direct experience with IPD is not a requirement.

Motivation

Integrated Project Delivery (IPD) has been successfully implemented in the US and Canada, however, adoption of IPD within Canada has been uneven. It is unclear why many building owners are hesitant to pursue IPD, what barriers different types of owners may face, and how to help owners overcome these barriers to IPD adoption.

Research Goals

The goals of this research are to better understand the factors that facilitate owner adoption of IPD, and to identify the barriers, challenges, benefits and opportunities for IPD implementation. This research is led by the University of British Columbia (UBC) and is sponsored by the Integrated Project Delivery Alliance (IPDA).

Event Details

The forum is organized in a workshop format where participants will discuss specific topics related to IPD implementation. The forum will include an information session on IPD, followed by two roundtable breakout sessions moderated by the research team, and end with lunch and a panel discussion of industry professionals experienced with IPD.
